





Compiling on Department Servers


1. Download WinScp from <https://winscp.net/eng/download.php> and install.
2. Connect to dev.cs.hacettepe.edu.tr server with your department account(b2xxxxxx).




3. Load your code to department account.




4. Download Putty from <http://the.earth.li/~sgtatham/putty/latest/x86/putty.exe>
5. Connect dev.cs.hacettepe.edu.tr server and enter your department account from console.
